PRIORITY 1. IMPLEMENT THE COMPASS PROGRAM AND OTHER PROJECTS TO REDUCE PHOSPHORUS/NUTRIENT ENRICHMENT, CONTAMINANTS SUCH AS CHLORIDE, AND AIS.

Project: Participate in Rum River One Watershed, One Plan development Plan is expected to be ready for review in fall, 2021

Project: AIS grant

Grant request has been approved; planning and implementation underway.

Project: Stop Spiny Campaign

Educational campaign to engage Mille Lacs boaters in cleaning effort.

Get the Lead Out

Participate in a statewide effort to reduce the use of lead tackle.

PRIORITY 2. DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT A MARKETING AND EDUCATION PLAN.

Project: Healthy Land, Healthy Lake Conference

The annual outreach and educational effort to engage watershed residents in steps they can take to improve water quality. Tentatively looking at September 18 for live event; may include online sessions.

Project: MLLWMG Topics

Ongoing series of short, informative written pieces addressing different aspects of watershed health.

Project: Community event presence

Participation in selected community events for outreach and education.

Project: Outreach to lake associations and resorts

Connecting with area groups interested in watershed health

PRIORITY 3. MONITOR, ANALYZE, and CONSOLIDATE WATER QUALITY DATA.

Project: Survey current monitoring activity

Provide an overview of what scientific data is being collected and interpreted.

Project: Create a summary of trends revealed in MLBO DNR data for posting to site and use as a Topic of the Month.

Make data about the health of Mille Lacs waters available to the public.

PRIORITY 4. ORGANIZATION

Project: Create "Annual Report" for MLLWMG to capture outcomes on an annual basis.

Capture and summarize organizational activities to maintain a record of the groups activities over time.

Project: Identify potential funding sources

Establish a set of resources that can support the group's projects; apply for grants as appropriate
