4. Activity Updates and Discussion

- Mille Lacs Compass Program (Jake): The 2022 Mille Lacs Compass Report was handed out and is on Mille Lacs SWCD website:

 Barb notes Appeldoorn's General Manager will be meeting with Lynn about a potential erosion control project for their beach.
 - One Watershed One Plan Rum River 2023 (Jake):
 - No new projects approved. Mille Lacs Projects are ongoing. Outreach is continuing.
 - \$760,000 of projects approved within the Rum River Watershed at March meeting. Projected \$1.1 million for 2024-25 projects starting July 2024. Now is the time to come forward with projects. Proposals should go through the SWCDs.
 - Example of project: Aitkin SWCD is doing drone survey of public lakeshore around Mille Lacs to identify erosion and BMPs to address.
 - Mille Lacs SWCD is awaiting hire of 3 FTE's to include a Rum River Watershed Coordinator.
 - AIS grant for 2023 (Janet): N/R
 - Get the Lead Out Tackle Exchange (John): Collected 6 large lead weights used for nets, est. 25# each today. There is a program for retailers to get rebates for carrying lead-free tackle via the MN Pollution Control Agency. John working with Aitkin SWCD for year round lead collection point.
 - "Keep it Clean" Campaign (Ann):
 - Keep It Clean enforcement included in Environmental Omnibus Bill passed. Group agrees Ann Bruccianni Lyon did amazing job in getting this legislation done.
 - Phase I Mille Lacs Dive assessment, Collin West 'Clean up the Lakes', funded by MPCA. Start June 2024. Bonnie Goshey is fiscal manager. Promotion pending.
 - Looking for funding for Phase II and III lake garbage cleanup for 2025-26. \$300,000 total cost. Jake notes that is in the timeframe for the next round of state funding for RR 1W1P.
